ERAC is currently looking to bring on a contracted Environmental Emergency (E2) & Emergency Response Plan (ERP) Specialist to assist with E2 drills and exercises across Canada.

Reporting to, and receiving direction from, the Safety & Emergency Management Director, the role of the contracted E2 & ERP Specialist will be to conduct tabletop exercises, perform drills and full-scale exercises involving dangerous goods and report writing. This role may also assist with the planning, developing and writing of E2 and ERP plans, policies, technical procedures and guidelines.

The successful contractor will need to possess,

- 5 years of experience in the flammable gas liquids industry,
- knowledge and experience with liquefied petroleum gas – propane,
- knowledge and experience within ICS and exercise facilitation,
- meet the requirements of CEPA, and
- excellent communication skills, both verbal and written.

Eligible reimbursements and expenses include:

- travel (airfare, hotel and car rentals)
- daily meal per diem when traveling
- paid kilometers
